ITALY IS COMPOSED OF 20 REGIONS AND TUSCANY IS ONE OF THEM.

TUSCANY IS LIMITED ON THE WEST COAST BY THE TYRRHENIAN SEA (WITH ITS BEAUTIFUL ARCHIPELAGO).

THE CITY OF FLORENCE (IN ITALIAN, FIRENZE) IS THE CAPITAL OF THE REGION OF TUSCANY.

IN ITALIAN THE WORD FOR TUSCANY IS TOSCANA (PRONOUNCED TOS' KA:NA)

Its land borders, starting from the north and clockwise are the regions of Liguria (home to the famous Cinque Terre), Emilia Romagna, Marche, Umbria and Lazio. To give you an idea of where Tuscany is, here is a list of the distances from other cities to **FLORENCE**:



300 km south of Milan

from London to Florence the distance is 1.600 km from New York to Florence it is 6.692.80 km from Melbourne to Florence, 16.03.08 km



The easiest way to reach Tuscany by plane is through the Florence international Airport or the Pisa international airport (this second one is more known for the low cost flights of many air companies).



Florence, because of its position, also has fast and efficient rail and motorway connections making it easy to reach the rest of the country.



You can also reach Tuscany by boat to the main Tuscan maritime Port of Leghorn. Ferries run from Leghorn/Livorno to Olbia (Sardinia), Genoa (Liquria), and Barcelona (Spain).

ANY TOWN YOU'LL BE IN WILL BE LISTED ESSENTIALLY UNDER ONE OF THESE PROVINCES WHICH ARE THE POLITICAL SUB-DIVISIONS OF THE REGION OF TUSCANY AND YOU CAN SEE THEM IN THIS MAP.
